## **The Daniel Centers for Progressive Judaism Awarded Three Year Grant by the Jewish Community Foundation of Los Angeles**

August 2010 - The Daniel Centers for Progressive Judaism is proud to announce that the Jewish Community Foundation of Los Angeles has awarded it with a generous three year grant for its *Jewish Soul Overhaul* program. The grant money supports training hundreds of teachers at three elementary schools in Tel Aviv and Jaffa in order to integrate Jewish education into their classroom curriculum and to encourage 2,000 students and their families to incorporate Jewish traditions and rituals into their daily lives.

The central mission of the Daniel Centers' education department is to advance, promote and develop pluralistic Judaic learning within the Israeli secular public school system. We view this as a re-connection process, where students, teachers, parents, families and communities reconnect to their heritage. This process leads to a wider re-connection to Jewish communities worldwide and the rich Jewish world of diverse streams and denominations. The Daniel Centers thanks the Jewish Community Foundation for its support of our important work in the education sphere.
